Dear Parents/Guardians,

Thanks to two of our athletic coaches who ran a car load of teenagers off our property last weekend! I appreciate the vigilance of all parents, staff and students who are helping us take care of our property.

New pumps have not been installed. Please remind your children to only flush toilet paper down the toilets.

The school budget has relied on a line item called Resource Development. Funds received from our Ladies Fashion Show, Shopping Cent\$, and Magazine Drive have generously funded this for many years. Six years ago, we received close to \$60,000 from these fund raisers. This year we have received \$50,000. Both Shopping Cent\$ and Magazine Drive need two chairs each to continue these valuable fundraising programs. Without these two programs tuition will increase substantially. If you can volunteer for either of these important programs we will be most grateful. Please contact the school office for more information.

We had 36 families apply on time and complete their application for the Catholic Education Foundation Tuition Assistance Fund. 15 families have received funds to a total of \$19,000.00!!!! There is a small amount of money left in the fund, there may be a third application session. Every school in the Archdiocese received money.
